INFORMATION BULLETIN Flood Debris Management Program Vedder River and Canal flood recovery work near Vedder River Campground

September 13, 2024

Background

Flood Recovery work will be happening near the Vedder River Campground. The Province, City of Chilliwack, City of Abbotsford, Sumas First Nation and the Fraser Valley Regional District have been working together to restore the Vedder River and Canal from the November 2021 Atmospheric River Event.

This work will ensure residents and recreationalists in the area can continue to live, work and play along the Vedder River.

Scope of Work

The site has no pit excavation. There will habitat enhancements created by developing a passage to allow flow to the off-channel habitat and Browne Creek wetland.

Safety Notices

- Please do not fish in the river in a vicinity (100m around)
- Please respect and abide by all signage
- Traffic controls will be in place

Schedule

Construction will start September 16, 2024 and is anticipated to be completed by September 19, 2024. Work hours near the campground will be 9am to 7pm Monday to Wednesday and 9am-5pm on Thursday, to limit disruption to campers.
