INFORMATION BULLETIN: Fireworks Prohibited in Electoral Areas F and G

In April 2024 the *Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Areas F and G Fireworks Regulation Bylaw No. 1739, 2024* was enacted. This Bylaw prohibits the sale of fireworks within Electoral Areas F and G.

DEFINITIONS

Fireworks

- » A substance or goods that is made, manufactured or used to produce an explosion or pyrotechnic device including but not limited to cannon crackers, fireballs, firecrackers, mines, Roman candles, skyrockets, squibs, torpedoes and any other explosive designated as a firework by regulation.
- » Fireworks as defined under the Canada Explosives Act [R.S.C. 1985] c. E-17 as amended.
- » Fireworks as defined under the Fireworks Act [RSBC 1996] Chapter 146 as amended.
- Sell
 - » Means, but is not limited to, sell, offer to sell, advertise for sale, display for sale, barter, dispose, distribute, furnish, give or trade.

PENALTY

- » Every person who disobeys or fails to comply with any provision of this bylaw commits an offence and is liable to a penalty of not more than \$3,000; and
- » Each date that a violation continues to exist shall constitute a separate offence.
